Until further notice for safety precautions due to Covid-19 the DeWitt County Central Appraisal District is allowing minimal public access to the building. We ask you to please observe the following practices:

2. A sign in sheet will be available inside the door for first come-first serve with a place for your telephone number to be listed. Please wait in your car for our call
3. We encourage use of a face mask

5. If you are sneezing, coughing or otherwise feel ill, please do not enter.

At this time face to face meetings are not permitted with the appraisers. We encourage you to use online methods or telephone to conduct business with us.
